We continue our efforts to both identify and remediate the dioxin contamination discussed in our March 13, 1995 letter to you. To that end, the following "plan of action and milestones" has been established through Southern Division, Naval Facilities Engineering Command:

- March 16, 1995: ABB will be on board CBC to develop a comprehensive soil sampling plan.
- March 30, 1995: Commence sample taking.
- April 13, 1995: Sample results available.

I will work with Southern Division in Charleston, SC and our remediation contractors to concurrently develop a remediation plan for execution as soon as the sampling results and state approval of the plan allow.
