Proposed Canal Road Dredge Pile Removal and On-Base PCB Cleanup

The Navy will be discussing two proposed environmental cleanups at the Public Meeting:

- 1) The Canal Road Dredge Pile cleanup proposal involves removal of dioxin-containing soil from a heavily wooded area along the west side of Canal Road and transporting it to the former Herbicide Orange Storage Area (Site 8 on the Seabee Base) where it would be stabilized using Portland cement or a similar material.
- 2) The PCB cleanup would involve removal of PCB-contaminated soil from a ditch on the Seabee Base near the Parade Field and transporting it to an off-site licensed landfill for proper disposal.

This meeting will open a **30-day Public Comment Period** for these cleanup proposals. Copies of the proposals and other associated reports will be available for review during the comment period at the NCBC Gulfport Information Repository located at the Orange Grove Branch Library, 12031 Mobile Avenue, Gulfport, MS 39503.
