The U.S. Navy, Naval Construction Battalion Center (NCBC) is submitting this Pre-construction Notification for its facility in Gulfport, Mississippi. The purpose of this letter fulfills the facility's requirement to submit notification to the District Engineer prior to commencing the activity described in the attached Corps of Engineers form 4345.

The activity described in the Pre-construction Notification is exempt from permitting by Nationwide Permit 38. 
