

The Mississippi Office of Pollution Control (OPC) has reviewed the above referenced document.
The following concerns were noted during document review.

1. The document does not address long term groundwater monitoring or provide an indication that monitoring is an integral part of the remedy. The document should provide a discussion on long term groundwater monitoring, including the frequency of monitoring and constituents monitored for. A separate groundwater monitoring plan should be submitted. A corrected version of the Decision Document should be submitted and approved by OPC prior to initiation of the recommended remedy.
2. It was noted during recent discussions that the Remedial Design Document is in preparation. OPC looks forward to receipt of the corrected Decision Document and draft Remedial Design Document.
