I have recently reviewed the above referenced document which we received on December 30, 1987. In general, the Bureau agrees with the findings and recommendations as outlined on pages 2, 3, and 4 of the report. These recommendations should be implemented as a necessary step in determining if there is any contamination present at each of the seven facility sites. In addition, it is recommended that hydrogeologic cross-sections be constructed from monitor/boring well logs, water level data, and any additional information available. Monitor well screen intervals should be compared to these cross-sections to assure that sampling is adequate to assess all possible contaminant pathways. It is understood that should any contamination be found, a Characterization Study will be instituted.

Please keep the Bureau informed regarding the status of investigation at each of the facility sites. In particular, the Bureau should be notified prior to any decision that would eliminate an area from further investigation.
