
Dear Carlos,

I am co-chairman of the environmental Restoration Advisory Board for the U.S. Navy Seabee Base Gulfport. The base Executive Officer, Commander Jack Zink, is the other co-chair. The board is made up of two dozen community citizens, including Dr. Barbara Thomas, and is charged with acting as a liaison between the Navy and the community in dealing with potential environmental hazards associated with the base.

The board would like to use the 28th Street Elementary School as the location for a community information program on January 11th from about the time school is out until 8 p.m. or so. Navy and civilian organizations would set up booths and demonstrations to provide information to the public about what is and has been stored on the base, prior and current clean-up operations, etc. Dr. Thomas expressed interest in the board using her school and would be there. We would make sure to leave things as we found them.

Please accept this as our formal request to use the building. When you have had time to think about our request and talk with Dr. Thomas, let me know and, assuming your response is favorable, we will work out any details you may deem necessary.
