# record for fourth straight day

lightly depressed levels but shot higher in the final hour on the strength of computer-driven buying programs. The Dow was up more than 50 points late in the day, prompting the New York Stock Exchange to pose trading restrictions in an attempt to smooth market activity.

"All week it's been the same pattern," said Larry Wachtel, market analyst at Prudential Securities. "We start out dull and then we come out in the last hour. It's like death and taxes."

Several broad market indexes also hit record highs for the fourth time, including the NYSE composite, up 83 to 349.15; the Standard &

Poor's 500 composite, up 6.13 to 656.06; and the American Stock Exchange's market value index, up 2.07 to 564.66.

The Nasdaq composite index rose 8.29 to 1,093.17, breaking its record high of 1,089.08 set last Tuesday.

Consumer stocks, which generally perform better during an economic contraction, were higher. The Dow industrials were led higher by consumer stocks Eastman Kodak, up 2 7/8 to 76 1/2; Coca-Cola, up 2 1/4 to 80 1/4; and Procter & Gamble, up 2 1/4 to 86.

Pharmaceutical stocks, another recession stalwart, rose as well, with Dow component Merck gaining 1 to 70, and Eli Lilly rising 1 7/8 to 61.
