Dear Captain DiGeorge:

On July 24, 1997 the Mississippi Commission on Environmental Quality followed staff recommendations and approved the delisting petition for the F028 ash piles located at the Naval Construction Battalion Center, Gulfport, Mississippi.

While approval of the delisting petition relieves NCBC of the responsibility of managing the ash as a RCRA hazardous waste, it does not alleviate any reporting requirements or activities as set forth under the State's CERCLA authority and Agreed Order No. 3466-97. Therefore, any future activities relating to the ash piles, as a separate project or as part of any site-wide (Site 8) project, should be addressed to Mr. Philip Weathersby, CERCLA Section, Hazardous Waste Division.
