1. Reference (a) requested assistance in obtaining Air Force action to resolve the remediation of the three Herbicide Orange sites at the Naval Construction Battalion Center, Gulfport, MS. The Air Force has previously taken responsibility for the cleanup and used an innovative technique involving a mobile incinerator to partially complete the cleanup. However, the site still needs to be delisted and closed to the satisfaction of the regulators.

2. This office has talked with the Air Force and they agree that they still have a responsibility to complete the cleanup. Mr. Tom Sims, Director, Eastern Regional Compliance Office, Air Force Center for Environmental Excellence, has been requested to participate with the Navy to resolve the problem.
