Northwest Landfill Cover Creates a New Soccer Field

The remedy for the Northwest Landfill (Site 3) included grading the existing soil cover to ensure that at least 2 feet of clean soil was present between the landfill contents and the soil surface. After grading, the soil was compacted and covered with sod. The area was designed to be used as a recreational soccer field after completion of the remedy. The site will be monitored using eight groundwater wells to make sure that the landfill contents do not move from the site.



The haul road was constructed of timbers removed as part of the off-base cleanup.

Haul Road Removed North of NCBC Gulfport

The haul road constructed during the dioxin cleanup north of NCBC Gulfport has recently been removed. The road was built from timbers cleared from the area in preparation for removal of contaminated soil. Logs from the road will be disposed in a green waste landfill.

Upcoming Restoration Advisory Board Meeting

The next NCBC Gulfport Restoration Advisory Board (RAB) Meeting is scheduled for July 14, 2014, from 6-7:30 PM at the Isiah Fredericks Community Center in Gulfport, Mississippi. The meeting will be held in an "availability session" format, meaning that the technical content will be presented using display boards and handouts and that the Environmental Restoration Program scientists and engineers will be available to discuss the content with the RAB members and interested community members. Participation in these discussions is highly encouraged.

The RAB meeting content will include two new topics, the *Remedial Investigation at World War II Landfill (Site 2)* and an update on the cleanup at *Northwest Landfill (Site 3)* and two ongoing topics, an *Environmental Restoration Program Update* and the *History of Dioxin at the Seabee Center*.



Community members are encouraged to participate in discussions with the technical team at all RAB meetings.
