I am responding for Secretary Weinberger to your letter of May 6 concerning American Electric's PCB disposal contracts. The Department will fully support your inquiry. Each of the installations you cited in your letter has been specifically notified of your investigation and asked to cooperate. If you wish to conduct inquiries at other locations, it would probably expedite matters if you notified me before you make local contacts so that we can assure a prompt response.

On the broad issue of Superfund cleanup at DoD installations, I understand Peter Daley, my Director of Environmental Policy, is already in contact with your staff. He is prepared to provide you any information we have available, as well as to brief you and your staff on various aspects of our program. I suggest you contact him directly at 695-7820 with your specific requests.

I would like to assure you that the Department is fully committed to a comprehensive program of hazardous material control and waste site cleanup. I welcome the opportunity to demonstrate this commitment by sharing the substance of our program with you.
