



We have reviewed your February 2 letter to us requesting a modification of parameter limits in the Industrial Waste Permit Number IO16-72883 for the Naval Air Station Hazardous Waste Disposal Site Cleanup.

The discharge limits for the parameters listed in the permit are the maximum allowed under Florida Administrative Code 17-3. Any higher limits would require a relief from stream standards. Should you wish to pursue this possible option, we would be glad to meet with you to discuss it further.


