Dear Sir:

In accordance with the above reference this Union request the following information:

1. The location of all Hazardous Waste Sites (Dumps) on N.A.S. Jacksonville that have been cleaned up in the last five (5) years and the approximate time frame (year) that the clean up was completed.
2. The location of all Hazardous Waste Sites on N.A.S. Jacksonville that have not been cleaned up and the estimated dates for beginning and for completion of the clean up of each site.
3. The amount of money designated for the Hazardous Waste Sites, on board N.A.S. Jacksonville, in fiscal year 1988 and the amount budgeted for fiscal years 1989 and 1990.
4. Information on any determination that has been made with respect to the threat that these sites currently, or in the future, pose to the St. Johns River and/or the groundwater/aquifer under N.A.S. Jacksonville.

This information is sought in an effort to protect Bargaining Unit employees from possible exposure to Hazardous Waste and also as a community service.

Since this information is in the public interest, and the majority of it has already been made available to your Public Affairs Officer (Mr. Nick Young), it is requested that all research and duplication cost be waived.

Thank you for your cooperation with regard to this matter.
