Dear NAS Jacksonville Housing Resident:

In January of 1992, two family housing meetings were held to discuss how the air station's environmental clean-up program affects you and your family. Since our last meeting, tests have been conducted of the air, water and soil in and around the Child Street area, located behind family housing.

Results identified some contamination within the fenced area and trace amounts in the ground water immediately outside the fenced area on the east side. Because of these findings, further tests will be conducted to determine the extent of the contamination before a clean-up plan can be proposed and tests on alternate methods of cleanup can be performed. As a precaution, please continue to keep your children and pets out of the fenced area.

Enclosed is an environmental fact sheet that will explain further the work being done to clean up this area. I appreciate your continuing interest in the work and want you to be involved in the decision making process.
