As the environmental cleanup at NAS Jacksonville is accelerated, the need to increase community involvement becomes more important. A Restoration Advisory Board (RAB) is being established to review community concerns and recommendations regarding cleanup activities. A meeting will be held at 7 p.m. on Thursday, February 23, at the Holiday Inn Orange Park, 150 Park Avenue (I-295 and Roosevelt Boulevard). Interested community members will be informed concerning the cleanup program in progress and will have an opportunity to ask questions. Applications will be available for membership on the RAB.

RAB members will be selected to make sure all interests of the community are represented. Once selected, members will meet regularly to review and comment on technical documents and plans relating to the ongoing environmental studies and cleanup activities at NAS Jacksonville. The RAB will serve as a forum for public comment into the Station cleanup program. Members will serve a two-year term to ensure that we build and maintain a strong RAB.
