Buildings 106/780: construction is on schedule; however, air sampling methodology question to be resolved by Station. Start up phase to be done by mid-January.
RI/FS: EPA and FDEP provided guidance on: FS from No Action to Groundwater Remediation. Partners will invite regulatory engineers to FS preparation as this issue develops. Scribe would like to restate that Drs. Roberts, Simon, and Wellman will be consulted on the Risk Assessment for NAS Jacksonville.
