Dear Mr. Ugolini:

Tetra Tech NUS, Inc. (TtNUS) received a letter from the Florida Department of Environmental Protection (FDEP) responding to the monitoring well inventory submitted in May 2001. This letter accepted the inventory and requested additional information, which is attached. This letter is a formal response to that request.

The following are the questions raised by Mr. Jorge Caspary of FDEP and our responses:

1. The FDEP would like to know what Line 8 (Miscellaneous Tanks) of the Petroleum Status Report Table refers to and what actions are being contemplated by Southern Division, Naval Facilities Engineering Command (SOUTHNAVFACENGCOM) or the installation in addressing soil and/or groundwater contamination.

Mr. Frank Sigona reported that this line item has been included on the list since before he managed the program. He has researched the item and it represents the tanks listed in items 21 through 24 from the same list. Therefore, it should not be considered a site and will be removed in the next version of this document.

2. "Also, please indicate whether sites described by line items 5, 6, 11, 12, 18, 19, 20, 21-24 are being funded by SDIV."

The sites included above are all being funded SOUTHNAVFACENGCOM with the exception of Site 6. Site 6 is a 24-inch Station Line, which is the portion of the Naval Air Station (NAS) Jacksonville to NAS Cecil Field 8-inch pipeline that is located between the tank farm and the property line. This is being funded by a separate command. The sites being funded by SOUTHNAVFACENGCOM are currently being screened for potential contamination. The screening results will be used by SOUTHNAVFACENGCOM to prioritize additional investigations and secure the funding for these efforts.


