**SUBJECT: SUBMITTAL OF VARIOUS REPORTS FOR SITE 119, NAVAL AIR STATION
 (NAS) JACKSONVILLE, JACKSONVILLE, FLORIDA.**

We are enclosing a summary of the groundwater analytical data at Area A, Site 119, Naval Air Station, Jacksonville. With the exception of benzene, which was detected in concentrations slightly higher than the State target level, analytical results from four quarters of monitoring show petroleum compound concentrations have decreased below the State groundwater cleanup target levels. We request a No Further Action Proposal for the site.

We are also enclosing the First Quarter 1998 Monitoring Only Letter Report for Areas B, C, and E, at Site 119, the First Quarter 1998 Groundwater Sampling Report for Area D at Site 119 and the Natural Attenuation Screening for Areas F and G at Site 119.
