Dear Mr. McGinnis:

The Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) concurs with the Navy's selected remedy for PSC 46 at Naval Air Station Jacksonville, which consists of the following:

- (1) Soil – Non-Residential (Industrial/Commercial) land use with construction and excavation restrictions for contaminated soil and preservation of paved surfaces.
- (2) Groundwater – Conduct Natural Attenuation Monitoring and impose human contact and water use controls:
 - a) Monitoring of groundwater contaminants for natural attenuation.
 - b) Prohibit groundwater withdrawal for potable or other use without Environmental Protection Agency and DEP approval.
 - c) Ensure that any construction workers that might come in contact with site groundwater are properly trained.
