Dear Mr. Gartland:

The Department has reviewed the subject document against the requirements of the interim RCRA groundwater monitoring plan for Building 101S.

Note that your detection limit for bis (2-chloroethyl)ether has been above its GCTL for some time. At some point, you will need to report it below its GCTL before the Department accepts closure of this site.

Your recommendations are acceptable. You may discontinue sampling for metals except for arsenic, and you no longer need to sample for TRPH. You may also go to annual monitoring in December.

Your interim groundwater monitoring plan must be implemented until such time that it is changed by the Department. It is expected that these interim groundwater monitoring requirements will be incorporated into the Record of Decision (ROD) as part of the selected remedy for Operable Unit 3 (OU-3). Once the ROD is approved and the selected remedy implemented, this interim plan will no longer be in effect. Until then, the next groundwater monitoring must occur in December 2013 and the report must be submitted to the Department no later than the last day of February 2014.


