The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) has received the final removal action workplan dated February 3, 1992, (via facsimile machine), for the Military Construction proposed within Operable Unit number three. EPA concurs with the Navy workplan as presented.


EPA requests advance notification for (1) the resumption of any field activities associated with this site and (2) all community relations activities related to this removal action.

Additionally, EPA wishes to remind the Navy that per 40 CFR §300.413(c) "Removal actions shall, to the extent practicable, contribute to the efficient performance of any anticipated long-term remedial action with respect to the release concerned". Movement of contaminated soils within the operable unit should comply with this requirement.

Please be advised that any such actions conducted in the future at this National Priorities Listed Site must comply fully with the National Contingency Plan and prior notification to both the EPA and State should be provided in accordance with the Federal Facility Agreement. Failure to do so could result in possible enforcement actions and/or the assessment of stipulated penalties.
