The Department has reviewed the Draft - Groundwater Focused Feasibility Study, Potential Source of Contamination 38 dated March 15, 2016, (received March 22, 2016), prepared and submitted by Resolutions Consultants under Contract Number N62470-11-D-8013. The Department has the following comments:

- Executive Summary, final paragraph - the word "alternates" is used three times when describing the three options under consideration. I am unfamiliar with the use of the word "alternates" in this context and think the word "alternatives" should be substituted.
- Section 2.1 - the stated goal of Groundwater RAO 1 is to "prevent unacceptable risks associated with potential human exposure..." The word is "unacceptable" is vague. What is unacceptable to one party may be unacceptable to another. Please clarify.
- Section 2.2. pg. 2-4, first sentence below Table 2-2 – The sentence is confusing. Is there a word missing? Please clarify.
