The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) has reviewed the Final Five-Year Review for Operable units (OU) 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, and 8 at the Jacksonville Naval Air Station. This is an official determination that the fourth Five-Year Review report is adequate for its intended purpose and that the EPA concurs with the protectiveness statements therein, as summarized below. The protectiveness statements will be reported to Congress.

This review included an evaluation of the remedial actions at eight OU. The remedies implemented at OU 1 and 3, are protective of human health and the environment in the short-term. Exposure pathways that could result in unacceptable risks have been controlled through remedial actions, where appropriate, and implementation of Land Use Controls (LUCs) until identified issues have been addressed. The remedies at the remaining OUs are protective of human health and the environment.

Thank you for your efforts in completing this five-year review and in working with EPA to include the necessary recommended actions to ensure that the selected remedies are protective of human health and the environment in the long term. The next five-year review due date for the fifth review is March 6, 2021.
