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PSC 18 Base Fill Area

6. Since this PSC is being addressed under the ongoing radiological survey, the Department concurs with the recommendation to wait until the radiological survey is finished before proceeding with the Remedial Response Decision System.

PSC 25 Building H2038

7. Since this PSC is being addressed under the ongoing radiological survey, the Department concurs with the recommendation to wait until the radiological survey is finished before proceeding with the Remedial Response Decision System.

PSC 36 Dewey Park


