Dear Mr. Patel:

We are requesting a 30 day extension, under 40 Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) 262.34(b) for hazardous waste generated from the closure of the NADEP, Building 101, plating tanks (the earliest accumulation date is July 21, 1993) at this installation. The waste is stored in large rolloffs which can not be managed at the Hazardous Waste Facility (HO16-119108) due to permit conditions dealing with size of the storage units and physical capacity. The 30 day extension is requested due to a failure of this installation to locate any facilities that are able to treat, under 40 CFR 268, the asbestos waste contaminated with waste codes D006, F007 and F008.

Due to this lack of treatment, this facility is seeking direct land disposal of the waste. Information has been mailed, as directed in the Federal Register of May 14, 1993 (page 28510), to the Chief of Training and Technical Assistance Branch, U.S. Environmental Protection Agency, Office of Waste Program Enforcement Branch (OS-520), 401 M Street, S.W. Washington, DC 20460. See enclosure 1 for documentation of our "good faith" efforts. We expect that the waste will be disposed within the 30 day extension period.
