Enclosed is a copy of the revised post-closure permit which contains the conditions that apply to the former electroplating shop (Building 101). Pursuant to my November 20, 1996 letter, you are required to publish and broadcast, at your own expense, the Notice of Proposed Agency Action that was included with that letter. Because the enclosed permit is substantially modified from that included with the Intent to Issue language, enclosed are revised newspaper and radio announcements.

Pursuant to Rule 62-730.220(9), F.A.C., the notice must be published one time only in the legal ad section of a major local newspaper of general circulation in Duval County and broadcast one time only over a local radio station within thirty (30) days of receipt of this letter. Proof of publication and broadcast must be provided to the Department within fourteen (14) days of publication


