Missouri Department of Natural Resources has reviewed the following document, received March 4, 1993, and has prepared comments:

*Remedial Action Report and Decision Documents and Final Closure Report for Sites SS03 and SS04, Oil Saturated Area and Hazardous Waste Drum Storage Area.*

1. Based on the document, it shows that sample SS03-SP92 was taken from borehole SS03 on February 6, 1992. Was this sample taken before or after the contaminated soil excavation done on that same day? The results from this sample (2000 mg/kg) show that TPH was in exceedance of cleanup standards of 100mg/kg. What does this result indicate? Were further samples taken from sites SS03 and SS04 to ensure that all of the contaminants, (based on cleanup standards) were removed? These cleanup standards are different from those used at the POL storage yard. Explain the difference.
2. In both the general description/site history and other maps for site SS04 in this document and other supporting documents, reference has been made to site SS04 having only a gravel lot, or only having an asphalt lot. Please clarify this discrepancy.
3. Has there been a TCLP test for metals on the soil from SS03 and SS04?
