Dear Mr. Esch:

The purpose of this letter is to comment on work which is currently taking place on the Base. The week of March 21, 1994 I observed a contractor installing a groundwater monitoring well on the dam of the Drainage Pond, just southwest of the POL Yard. A review of the Work Plan revealed no intention of installing a well. The same review showed the Pond being underlain by perforated transite drain pipe. A visual inspection of the site revealed that even though the Pond was dry, the transite pipe outfall had a substantial discharge. Obviously the transite drain system was intercepting the groundwater and provided a monitoring point without the need for a groundwater monitoring well.

The Work Plan also specified sampling to be conducted for soils in this area, as well as other water sources. Please see to it that the contractor follows the Work Plan as approved.

I would also like to be kept informed of any proposed modifications to documents that have had approval from this office.
