Dear Mr. Harris,

As we discussed at our meeting at the former Richards-Gebaur AFB on August 8, 2006, there is a significant number of monitoring wells at the installation that are not currently being sampled as part of the ongoing groundwater monitoring program. These wells are candidates for decommissioning when they are not deemed necessary for contingency purposes. After a thorough review of the most recent groundwater monitoring data, we have identified 15 monitoring wells that AFRPA believes no longer serve a useful purpose and should be decommissioned. The attached table identifies the monitoring wells proposed for decommissioning along with supporting rationale.

AFRPA requests your concurrence on the wells proposed for decommissioning. Your prompt attention to this matter is requested so that appropriate funds may be secured during the current fiscal year. Should you have any questions, please contact me at (210) 925-3050.
