The Department has completed the technical review of the above referenced document dated March 2003 (received March 17, 2003) and has the following comment:

1. The Department recommends that monitoring well AIC-MW-05D-0702 be resampled for volatile organic compounds. Two clean sampling events will enable the site to have an unconditional NFA in place of the conditional NFA that would be required with the present groundwater sampling data.


