1. **Page2-4 Sections 2.3.4 Potential Migration Pathways and 2.3.5 Potential Receptors:** During the last partnering meeting held in January 2012, we discussed the potable pipeline that is buried in the southern sliver and how it may be a potential receptor for Polychlorinated Biphenyls (PCBs) found in the surface and subsurface soil.
