
Dear Mr. Glover:

I have reviewed the CAR dated October 1996 (received October 9, 1996) submitted for the subject site. Therefore, you must now submit a Remedial Action Plan (RAP) in accordance with Rule 62-770.700, F.A.C. and Southern Division's 1997 Petroleum Site Management Plan.

Please submit two copies of the RAP addressed to Mr. Greg M. Brown, Technical Review Section, Bureau of Waste Cleanup within the time framework specified in the above refernced management plan.


