With reference to the above-captioned license and a December 4, 1980 letter from Mr. W. J. Woods, Director of the Real Estate Division, Charleston NAVFAC to Camden County, please consider this as a request to further extend Camden County's use of land at Kings Bay for sanitary landfill until June 15, 1981.

While our contractor is nearing completion of the new landfill and estimates that we can begin to use a portion of it for solid waste disposal by the middle of May, it may take longer to receive authorization from the appropriate permitting agency. Therefore, we respectfully request that we be authorized to continue use of the Kings Bay site until June 15, 1981. I will notify you if any of these circumstances change.

Your continued cooperation in transferring the County's solid waste operations off the Base is appreciated.
