Dear Mr. Ledbetter:

The Naval Submarine Base (SUBASE), Kings Bay, Georgia was given a variance on May 18, 1981 to continue existing hazardous waste storage operations during the permit review process. In your June 18, 1982 letter, this variance was extended to May 18, 1983. To insure continued compliance with Chapter 391-3-11-.10 of the Georgia Rules for Hazardous Waste Management, SUBASE Kings Bay would like to enter into a consent agreement establishing time tables for permit submittal and operating conditions until the permit is issued. Accordingly, the following consent agreement is proposed:

1. SUBASE Kings Bay may continue existing hazardous waste facility operations contingent upon the following:

(a) Compliance with applicable portions of Section 391-3-11-.10, Part 265 of the Georgia Rules for Hazardous Waste Management.

(b) The continued operation of these facilities may not present undue present or potential threat to the environment or health of humans.

(c) Any deficiencies as identified by a duly appointed representative of the Director of the Environmental Protection Division (EPD) as part of an inspection will be corrected on a time schedule mutually agreeable to EPD and SUBASE Kings Bay.

2. SUBASE Kings Bay will submit a Part B permit identifying existing interim status hazardous waste storage facilities and planned final standard hazardous waste storage facilities within 180 days of acceptance of this consent agreement.
