I would appreciate your immediate attention to the concerns of Camden County, the U. S. Navy, and its personnel regarding surface water usage at residential areas adjoining base property. It is my understanding that initial testings are showing high levels of impurities that might threaten human consumption or usage for auxiliary purposes.

Much of the area is utilizing or accessible to a public water system and I feel that you are already involved with reasonable remedy or options to assist the county or Navy in these concerns.

I will be personally grateful to you for your assisting the county in the appropriate filings for any relief that might qualify them for assistance from the Super Fund in this instance. I want to thank you for all past considerations and am aware of the statewide impact that these problems are having on your limited personnel.
