KINGS BAY SUBMARINE BASE PHASE III LANDFILL

Your concerns regarding the Naval Submarine Base, Kings Bay Phase III Landfill, as expressed by your letter of June 19, 1992, are acknowledged. The landfill was closed for acceptance of waste in 1991 and no further use is intended. We assure you there will be no repeat occurrences of overfill. The waste has been covered and we are assessing the need for additional cover to meet EPA requirements.

By this letter, our application for vertical expansion, submitted by our letter of February 27, 1990, is officially withdrawn.

A Closure/Post Closure Plan for the Phase III Landfill, including the overfill will be prepared; however, we request an extended date for submission of March 19, 1993.
