David Driggers at Southern Division, Naval Facilities Engineering Command, requested that I mail you a copy of the USGS letter sent to Ed Lohr on November 1, 1993. The copy is enclosed.

Pumping rates as low as 6.5 gallons per minute were evidently sufficient for the aquifer tests at Kings Bay, as we discussed by phone yesterday, so the concerns expressed in the enclosure regarding possible underestimation of necessary pumping rates are alleviated.
