Dear Mr. Khaleghi:

We acknowledge receipt of your March 9, 1994 letter granting extensions for the submission of various reports and workplans associated with Sites 2, 5 and 16. Enclosure (1), our response to comments on the RFI Report, Sites 5, 12 and 16, is forwarded for review pending finalization of the revised RFI Report.

Due to the extent of comments and to allow for adequate internal review time, we request an additional time extension to the required submittal date for the revised RFI Report, Sites 5 and 16. As discussed at our Technical Review Committee (TRC) meeting on March 22, 1994, we need until June 15, 1994 to prepare and submit the revised report. Your Ms. Madeleine Kellam indicated this timeframe was acceptable.

Regarding the two workplans referenced in your letter, we will need an extension to the current submittal dates for those workplans. As also discussed with Ms. Kellam, we are developing our schedules for preparation of those workplans and will advise you of our proposed submittal dates within two weeks.

We appreciate your attendance at our TRC Meeting and Public Information Session. Your advice and comments were extremely helpful and are key to the steady progress we are making on the Installation Restoration Program at Kings Bay.
