
RE: Investigation Derived Waste

Dear Captain O'Neil:

The Georgia Environmental Protection Division (EPD) has received the Navy's letter of March 4, 1994 requesting approval for its plan to dispose of Investigation Derived Waste (IDW). Based on a review of the analytical data, EPD approves the request to return the solid IDW from advancement of soil borings and monitoring wells (drill cuttings, drilling mud, and grout) to the confines of Site 11. The remainder of the solid IDW (disposable plastic sheeting and personal protective equipment) should be disposed at a Subtitle D landfill, as proposed.
