Per your 13 May 1994 letter, the enclosed signed Consent Order is returned.

By signing the Consent Order, enclosure (1), which addresses issues raised by your hazardous waste inspector on February 10 - 12, 1993, I am not waiving the requirements of the Anti-Deficiency Act, 31 U.S.C. § 1342, for this or any future financial obligations incurred by Naval Submarine Base (NSB), Kings Bay to the State of Georgia. Because this Consent Order calls for payment or obligation of a sum certain (\$50,000 in penalties and supplemental environmental projects) and that the requisite funds specifically to satisfy this obligation are presently available at NSB Kings Bay, the requirements of the Anti-Deficiency are not violated.

Request you revise Attachment I of the Consent Order to reflect completion of Field Work in May and June 1995 and 1996 vice 1994 and 1995. Both your and our Natural Resources professionals agree that no actual sampling and monitoring will occur this year due to the delay in finalizing execution of the Consent Order. However, initial field work to establish the approximately 30 sampling points can be accomplished.
