We have received your February 28, 1995 Notice of Violation (NOV) related to Naval Submarine Base, Kings Bay's (SUBASE) Permit No. HW-014(S)(2). This NOV was issued for failure to inspect several hazardous waste drums in the Permitted Storage Building and for storage of one container of waste labeled "unknown" and dated October 28, 1993.

The incorrect accumulation dates were immediately corrected on the day of inspection and we have properly identified and disposed of the "unknown" waste through the Defense Reutilization and Marketing Service. Accordingly, this corrects both deficiencies identified under this NOV.

We have reviewed our procedures and are establishing additional self-inspection systems in cooperation with our Base Operating Services Contractor to ensure these deficiencies are not repeated.
