We have reviewed the above-referenced response to our June 14, 1995 Notice of Deficiency, and concur with Subbase's decision to withdraw this report. We greatly appreciate your willingness to work with us on this important subject. Because this decision impacts the previously approved Corrective Action Plan schedule, Subbase should, within 15 days of receipt of this letter, provide a revised schedule for corrective action. We suggest a due date in January, 1996 for a brief report revisiting the Interim Measure operation in light of the anticipated findings of the new work by the United States Geological Survey, and a proposed Corrective Action Plan incorporating those findings.
