Mr. Hendricks,

We have a 20 cubic yard roll-off dumpster approximately half full of sand from redevelopment of recovery wells 1-4 and soil, drilling mud, and grout from the installation of the new well RW06. A sample from the dumpster has been analyzed for all the TCLP constituents. Only one TCLP constituent, barium, was detected in the sample. The concentration of barium was 580 ug/l, which is well below the TCLP regulatory level for barium, 100,000 ug/l. We would like to ask for permission to dipose of the soil within the boundary of Site 11. This has been done at this site in the past. I wanted to touch base with you on this matter before I drafted any official correspondence.
