
Dear Sir:

Georgia EPD has completed its review of the referenced Semi-Annual Corrective Action Assessment Report for the Old Camden County Landfill (Site 11 Semi-Annual Report). The comments herein are based on a review of the referenced document, and on field observations made by EPD personnel on a February 12, 2001 Corrective Action Oversight (CAO) inspection of Site 11.

EPD has identified no deficiencies in the Site 11 Semi-Annual Report. However, during the February 12 CAO of the Site 11 monitoring network, EPD personnel observed an apparent 6-inch diameter well located along the dirt road on the eastern boundary of Site 11, near Monitoring Well KBA-11-11A. NSB should provide EPD with the following information pertaining to this apparent well: documentation of its purpose, a boring log, and a well-construction diagram.

Please notify EPD of the date of the next planned Site 11 ground-water sampling event. Please do not hesitate to contact Larry Papetti or Billy Hendricks of my staff at (404) 656-2833 if you have any questions.

The 6" well at site 11 is USGS well 33E116. Part of their report is attached. Page 10 describes what they drilled through, down to 300 feet. They then cemented it up to 110 feet, as shown on page 18. Chris Leeth at USGS (770-903-0120) also has hand notes.

I will talk to Anthony about abandoning it.

We can sample at site 11 during the first week of May - are you available then?
