Dear Sir:

We have reviewed your request to modify your Corrective Action Plan to remove the ex-situ groundwater treatment equipment and three extraction wells at Site 11, the Old Camden County Landfill, at your facility. The requested changes are approvable under the following conditions:

1. The base must review its Corrective Action Plan and submit to the Director for approval change pages to that document and, if necessary, to the current Permit Application. A modification to the permit may be required. Keep in mind that the permit will likely need modification shortly to incorporate changes to the status of other Solid Waste Management Units currently under investigation.
2. The three groundwater extraction wells, and any other wells being considered for closure, must be properly abandoned in accordance with the Georgia Water Well Standards Act.
3. The ex-situ groundwater treatment system, both equipment and structure, may be removed at your convenience. The carbon canister air-stripper control media is solid waste and must be characterized as to whether it is hazardous waste. The remaining equipment may be handled as resalable equipment or scrap metal. If it is to be disposed of, it must be similarly characterized.
