

We have reviewed your initial report of a spill of hydraulic fluid adjacent to the Equipment Maintenance Building, Building 3020, at the Naval Submarine Base Kings Bay. This notification is acceptable as submitted, and satisfies the reporting requirement of Section I.C.4. and 5. of your Hazardous Waste Facility Permit, number HW-014(S&T)-3. If this spill cannot be completely remediated within 180 days of its occurrence, Subase must report this release to the Director as a newly identified Solid Waste Management Unit in accordance with Section V.B. of your Permit.
