Dear Mr. Khaleghi:

This letter will serve as our final Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA) Facility Investigation (RFI) Report for Solid Waste Management Unit number 5, Fire Fighting Pit, Installation Restoration Site 2. We have verified that this site was remediated by removal of all contaminated media.

Our "RFI Report for Sites 5 and 16, and Site History and File Information for Site 12" dated June, 1994, indicates that this site was an unlined fire-fighting training pit used from 1979 to 1981. It was approximately 30 feet by 30 feet by two feet deep, located in the waterfront area near the current hull shop (building 5085). We tested a soil core sample from the pit, verified that it was not hazardous, then hauled approximately 100 cubic yards of pit sludge to the Camden County Landfill (which we currently monitor as Solid Waste Management Unit number 3, Installation Restoration Site 11).

We then dredged soil from this area (as deep as 37 feet below original grade), replaced it with compacted fill, and paved much of this area, according to construction drawings for the drydock and hull shop.


