With your approval, Naval Submarine Base Kings Bay, GA would like to reduce the frequency of monitoring for the irrigation well at 108 Cottage Court from monthly to annually.

This well met the groundwater protection standard during the years 2000 and 2001 as shown by enclosure (1) and (2). Our approved groundwater monitoring plan, section 3, would allow this reduction in sampling frequency if this was a compliance monitoring well.
