Dear Mr. Rabon:

A certified well driller properly abandoned 74 injection wells at the old Camden County Landfill, IR site 11, starting on March 17 and finishing on March 27, 2003.

These injection wells were used for chemical oxidation treatment of chlorinated solvent contamination in accordance with Underground Injection Control Permit number 089-B. Specific locations are listed in the Construction Completion Report for Site 11 (Aug 2002), Appendix B, injection points I-1 through I-44 and I60 through I89.

We asked for permission to remove these injection points on May 21, 2002. Permission was granted in your letter of June 14, 2002. We awarded a contract to Newman Drilling, 208 Rowell Rd, Waycross, GA 31503, (912) 285-9379, license #407. Newman Drilling pressure-grouted each well from the bottom, cut off the casing approximately two feet below surface, and capped each casing with concrete. They then smoothed the surface to grade.

I certify under penalty of law that this document and all attachments were prepared under my direct supervision in accordance with a system designed to assure that qualified personnel properly gather and evaluate the information submitted. Based on my inquiry of the person or persons who manage the system, or those persons directly responsible for gathering the information, the information submitted is, to the best of my knowledge and belief, true, accurate, and complete.




