The regulatory process for discharging to the Base LAS are identical to the requirements for the City's POTW - only through a different department. The Base's LAS is permitted under the Industrial Wastewater Program.

A Consent Order can be issued allowing discharge to the Base's LAS. A letter requesting permission for discharge should be sent to Larry Hedges' (Larry Kloet's supervisor) attention. The letter should include:

- Groundwater data and parameters to be treated
- Treatment system design and plans
- Information on GW treatment system flow, current LAS flow and LAS permitted capacity

Process will probably take only 30 days from receipt of all information.

A permit modification is only needed if we wanted to discharge contaminated water to the LAS (in which case the GW monitoring requirements in the permit would be revised accordingly) or if we anticipated exceeding their permitted capacity.
